

Virtual Physician FIND October 4th, 2023 Frequently Asked Questions

What will Physician FIND look like?

Physician FIND will be completely virtual and will take place via Zoom on Wednesday, October 4th from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM ET. The first hour (6:00 PM-7:00 PM ET) will be an Information Session followed by two hours (7:00-9:00 PM ET) of virtual Networking Sessions with all recruiting sponsor companies. Candidates will be asked to mute their microphones during the Information Session portion of the agenda. The Information Session will be recorded and posted for viewing on the RPIF website at a later date.

What do I need to do to prepare for Physician FIND?

Come prepared with any questions you may have, otherwise no further preparation is required prior to the attendance of Physician FIND. Visit <https://pharmafellows.rutgers.edu/physicians> to familiarize yourself with the Physician Fellowship Program.

Because FIND is virtual, will I be able to network with my companies of interest?

Yes, following the first hour, candidates will have two hours to network with recruiting sponsor companies. Each recruiting company will have a breakout room on Zoom and the candidates can move around from room to room for the duration of 2 hours.

How do I sign up for Physician FIND?

Registration for Physician FIND will be open on the RPIF Website on September 1st at 9:00 AM ET. Registration is open only to those who hold an MD or DO degree as of July 1, 2024. Fellowship and/or residency training is highly preferred, and each position may have preferences on clinical practice experience requirements. Candidates will be asked to provide their contact information, functional areas of interest, and will have the opportunity to submit questions in advance.

Where can I learn more about recruitment for RPIF this year?

The Fellow Recruitment Committee will be presenting on this topic during the first hour of the Physician FIND Information Session.

How can I research the positions I am interested in prior to the FIND event?

Information on the positions being offered and host companies will become available on the RPIF website by September.
